Dear HE Keo Rottanak,

I am delighted to announce that applications for the Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships intake 2017 is now open and close on 30 June 2016.

The **Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships**, the Australian Government's internationally competitive, merit-based scholarships, provide opportunities for citizens of participating countries including Cambodia to undertake vocational or post-graduate study, research and professional development in Australia.

Scholarships are also available for Australians to undertake research and professional development in Cambodia.

I strongly encourage suitably qualified Cambodia citizens to apply for Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships:

Endeavour Postgraduate Scholarships

- Eligible programs: Masters and PhD
- IELTS 6.5 or equivalent
- Duration: up to 2 years for Masters and up to 4 years for PhD
- Value: up to **AUD140,500** for Masters and up to **AUD272,500** for PhD

Endeavour Vocational Education and Training (VET) Scholarships

- Eligible programs: Australian Diploma or Advanced Diploma
- IELTS 6.5 or equivalent and a bachelor degree
- Duration: up to 2.5 years
- Value: up to **AUD131,000**

Endeavour Research Fellowships

- Eligible programs: research in Australia towards a Master or PhD degree program at a Lao university or for postdoctoral research
- IELTS 6.5 or equivalent (or as approved by the Australian institution)
- Duration: 4 – 6 months
- Value: up to **AUD24,500**

Endeavour Executive Fellowships

- Eligible program: professional development
- IELTS 6.5 or equivalent (or as approved by the Australian institution)
- Duration: 1 – 4 months
- Value: up to **AUD18,500**

- *Individual case managers in Australia to provide support throughout the award*



Advice for preparing a high quality application for an Endeavour Award

1. Allow sufficient time to prepare a high quality application. Develop a timetable for completing your application including reviewing the application prior to submitting. Do not leave your application until the last minute.
2. Think about what you are trying to achieve (personally, professionally and academically) through this program. Clearly outline your goals to give the Selection Committee an insight into your aspirations and demonstrate your commitment to your selected field.
3. Refer frequently to the Selection Criteria (on the Endeavour Awards website) to ensure that you address each criterion. The Selection Committee will assess your application against these selection criteria.
4. Advise your referees that you are applying for an Endeavour Award, their role and the timeline. You may consider inviting them to review your draft application and provide you with comments.
5. Outline clearly and concisely your reason for choosing your field of study e.g. the relationship to local and international issues (such as economic, government, social and political developments).
6. Explain the benefits of your proposed program to current issues and future developments in your host country, Australia and globally.
7. Provide concrete examples of your past achievements to support your study or research.
8. Outline, using concrete examples, the potential future benefits and linkages which will result from your proposed program at the individual, organisational and country level.
9. Review, edit and spell-check your application prior to submission.

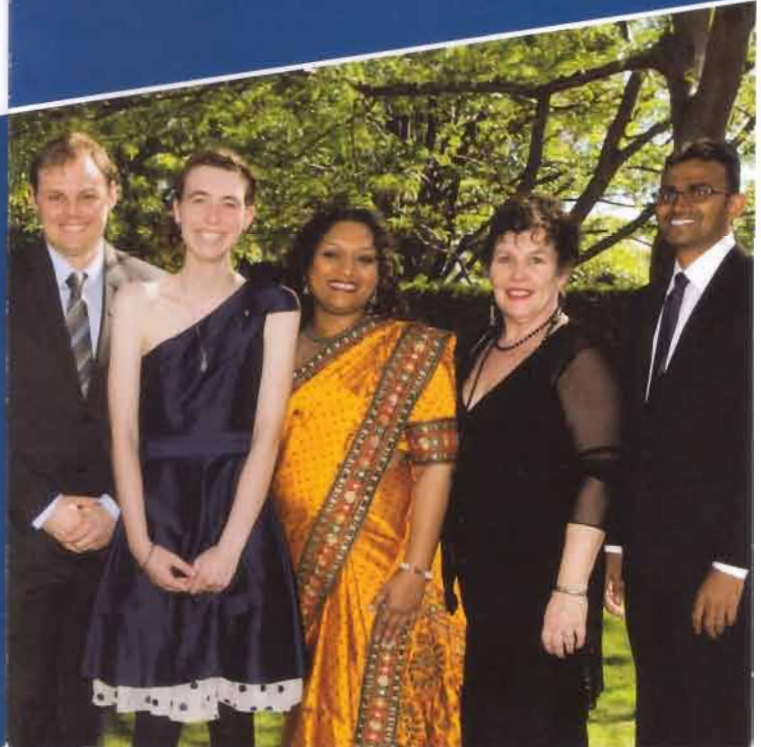
